Improving data management and reporting across 13 secondary schools

A need for better data insights and advanced reporting

West Lothian Council (WLC) utilise the cloud-hosted Fusion Cashless catering system and iPayimpact online payments across all 13 secondary schools.

Looking to consolidate data from multiple products and schools, WLC collaborated with CRB Cunninghams to develop the Data Factory hosted on Azure. This innovative product enables improved data management and real-time reporting through Power BI dashboards.





The challenge: reducing the risk of system failures

- System Failures: frequent downtimes due to the system being installed on individual PCs.
- Inefficient Data Management: manual daily backups and data copying increased the risk of data loss and system failure.
- Reporting Limitations: data was copied to an on-premises server nightly for management reporting via Crystal Reports, and data from the iPayimpact online payment system required additional copying from CRBC servers.



Solutions

To address these challenges, WLC opted for a comprehensive solution that integrated the following components:

- ✓ Fusion Cashless System: the system was rolled out across 13 secondary schools to facilitate seamless cashless transactions.
- Azure Data Warehouse: a centralised data repository was developed to store and manage large volumes of data efficiently.
- ✓ Power BI: a utilised tool to create detailed reports and interactive dashboards, enabling better data visualisation and decision-making.






The results
